## UNIFORM POLICY

It is a requirement of our school that all children wear school uniform every day. Wearing uniform enables children to gain a sense of identity and belonging within the school community and it helps children to feel 'ready to learn'.

From time to time, there may be genuine reasons why children can not adhere to the uniform policy in its entirety, for example a medical reason or injury. In these circumstances, we encourage families to talk to the school and we will always work together to support you and your child.

### **What will my child need?**

When children come to school, they will need to wear:

- a red or white 'polo' shirt;
- a red jumper or cardigan;
- grey or black trousers or skirts and in summer, dresses should be red and white;
- black shoes or black trainer like shoes with no markings. Boots (in the winter months) and sandals (in the summer months) are permitted but these must be flat and not have a heel;
- a red school fleece;
- A school book bag (all Key Stages). Children must not bring rucksacks to school as we have nowhere to store these.

An adult's discarded shirt – cut down in size - makes a suitable garment for use in art and design lessons and this will prevent paint or adhesives getting on to normal clothes.

### **P.E Kits**

Indoor kit should be:

- a plain white t-shirt;
- black shorts or skirt;
- black trainers or plimsolls.

Outdoor kit should be the same as above with the option of:

- a red fleece;
- black tracksuit trousers or leggings.

PE kit must be stored in a simple drawstring bag and correctly labelled please.

## Parental Responsibility

It is parents' responsibility to:

- ensure that their child wears warm clothes in winter and cooler clothing in summer to cope with the variations in temperature which occur in a large building;
- ensure that **ALL clothing is clearly named**. School staff will always try to help children find lost items however, if these are not named, we cannot ensure they are returned to you;
- provide others items such as wellingtons and waterproofs if requested by class teachers.

## Jewellery

We do not allow children to wear jewellery to school. If parents make the decision to allow their child to have pierced ears, 'sleepers' are the only earrings permitted and can be worn to join in with P.E and games if parents are aware of the risks involved and are willing to give their permission in writing for their child to participate in these lessons. If you have a child at school who wear 'sleepers' and you wish him/her to continue doing P.E and Games, would you please complete the declaration form. These can be obtained at the office.
